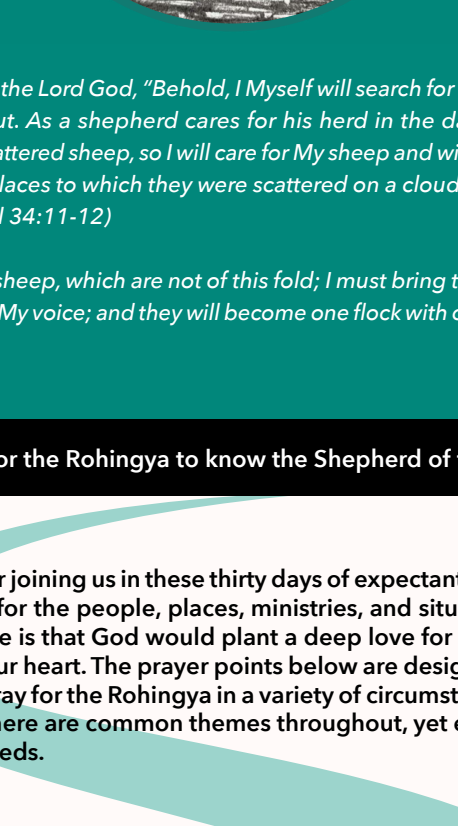

Following the Shepherd

'For thus says the Lord God, "Behold, I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out. As a shepherd cares for his herd in the day when he is among his scattered sheep, so I will care for My sheep and will deliver them from all the places to which they were scattered on a cloudy and gloomy day."' (Ezekiel 34:11-12)

'I have other sheep, which are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will hear My voice; and they will become one flock with one shepherd.' (John 10:16)

Praying for the Rohingya to know the Shepherd of their souls

Thank you for joining us in these thirty days of expectant intercession. As you pray for the people, places, ministries, and situations before you, our hope is that God would plant a deep love for the Rohingya people in your heart. The prayer points below are designed to guide you as you pray for the Rohingya in a variety of circumstances around the world. There are common themes throughout, yet each field has its unique needs.



USA

1

Pray for the Body of Christ in America to be welcoming to the stranger and to love sacrificially. Pray that they see and hear the heart cries of the Rohingya that God, in His sovereignty, has brought to cities across the USA, whether in large numbers (like Milwaukee, WI) or small (like Kalamazoo, MI).

2

A Rohingya Christian family is struggling to make ends meet in America. Additionally, there are not many Rohingya families in their city. Pray for provision for this family, direction on whether they should move cities to where more Rohingya are, and for them to be further built up in Christ.

3

Pray for the Rohingya across the USA who are hearing the Word of God, that they would have soft hearts and understanding to receive the Truth. In particular, pray for two men as they begin to see what God's Word reveals about Jesus and feel God gently stirring their hearts. Pray for those hardened to Jesus to experience a breakthrough in openness.

MYANMAR

4

Civil war continues in Myanmar, and the Arakan Army controls most of Rakhine state. Conditions are difficult. Food prices have soared, movement is restricted, and services are hard to access. Pray for the Rohingya in Myanmar, who feel harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd, to hear of and believe the news of a Shepherd who longs to care for them.

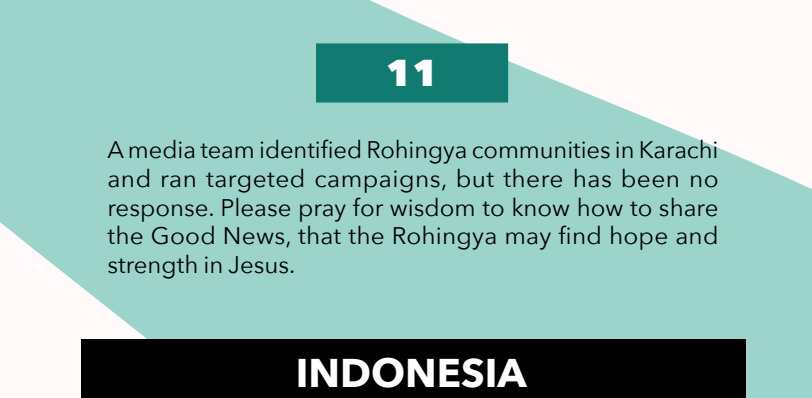
Myanmar continues in a state of brokenness. Pray for those in leadership to feel conviction about neglect and harm done to people like the Rohingya. Ask boldly for the gospel to transform the lives of those in power, that they might become caring, Christ-like shepherds.

INDIA

6

Rohingya Christians living in India face persecution and threats from some within their own Rohingya community, as well as the constant risk of deportation. Pray that they would be strengthened and sustained by the hope declared in Psalm 23:4:

'Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.'



7

Pray for the Rohingya church to grow in Christlikeness, reflecting His love and truth. Ask God to strengthen the believers and raise up shepherds who are committed to guiding the church with wisdom and integrity.

8

Pray for continued progress on the audio Bible translation, that the Rohingya around the world might hear the good news.

9

A group of Christian and Muslim Rohingya were deported from India in 2025 and are now under escort by a religious group in Myanmar, and are now under escort to leave the country alive. Pray for their protection as they journey, that they would encounter the Lord who 'prepares a table before [them] in the presence of their enemies,' (Psalm 23:5) and that the believers' trust in the Lord's guidance would serve as a witness to the rest of the group.

PAKISTAN

10

Around half a million Rohingya are living in Pakistan, primarily in Karachi. As far as we know, no one currently knows Jesus as their personal Shepherd or follows Him. Please pray that during Ramadan, Jesus would reveal Himself to them through dreams or visions and draw many to Himself.

11

A media team identified Rohingya communities in Karachi and ran targeted campaigns, but there has been no response. Please pray for wisdom to know how to share the Good News, that the Rohingya may find hope and strength in Jesus.

INDONESIA

12

Pray that those in Indonesia who hear Scripture audio encounter God, and that the Holy Spirit opens their hearts to see who Jesus truly is. Pray also for mercy and compassionate care from the local community in the North Sumatran province of Aceh.



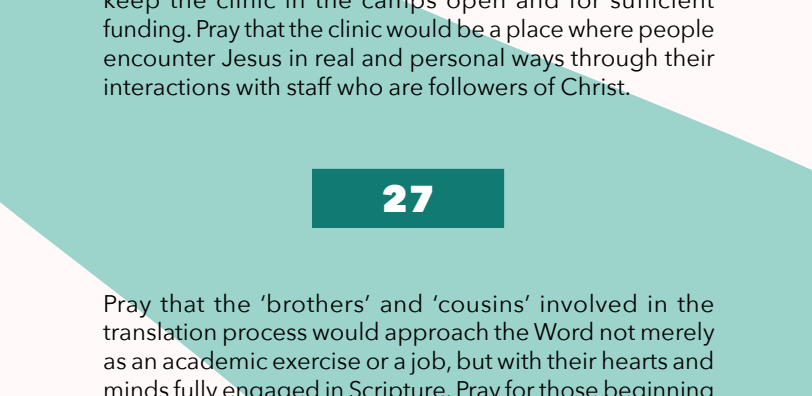
MALAYSIA

13

M. recently arrived in Malaysia by boat and is traumatised from his journey. He is staying with his brother, who already follows Jesus and has shared openly. Pray for M. and other new arrivals, for Jesus to meet them powerfully and bring healing.

14

H. has lived in Malaysia for 13 years. Last year, her life took a tragic turn when her husband died from diabetes, leaving her to care for young children with no source of income. Pray that H. would experience the Way Maker creating 'a path in the wilderness' (Isaiah 43:19), providing for both her spiritual and practical needs.



15

Workplace raids are increasing, leaving many Rohingya men in detention and forcing families to survive without support. S. has not seen her husband for nearly a year and cares for her two daughters alone. M. faced her husband's detention while nine months pregnant. Pray that these families experience Jesus as their provider and faithful friend.

16

A. has followed Jesus for several years and actively shares his faith, using any time off work to visit homes or send Bible story videos to friends. Pray for perseverance in his walk with the Lord and for continued zeal as he lovingly invites his people to trust the Good Shepherd.

NEPAL

17

An initiative run by believers provided homes for 83 Rohingya people in Nepal. Unfortunately, a neighbour in the community complained after a few months, and the police removed them. Pray for a way forward - that God would grant favour as this group of believers seeks to bring safety, hope, and dignity to their Rohingya friends.

18

Praise God for a new Muslim-background believer (MBB) among the Rohingya in Nepal! A believer from another country helped lead him to faith, and a local believer is guiding him on the straight path. Please pray for this new brother's protection and guidance as he grows in Christ.

JORDAN

19

As far as we know, there has been no focused effort to reach the Rohingya in Jordan. Pray that God would place it on the hearts of His people to see these Rohingya as needing guidance and care, like sheep without a shepherd. Pray that they would be adopted in prayer and faithfully pursued by followers of the Good Shepherd.

SAUDI ARABIA

20

There are no known workers specifically reaching the Rohingya in Saudi Arabia. Pray that believers would be moved with compassion for the estimated 500,000 Rohingya there, who have never heard of the love and care of their Shepherd. Pray for open doors for workers to enter the field and faithfully share the gospel.

21

Rohingya homes in cities across the country continue to be destroyed as the government clears land for modernisation and development. Pray for those displaced once again, and for those who still have their homes but are struggling, to encounter the kind Shepherd of their souls, who can be their strength each day.

THAILAND

22

Over 300 young Rohingya are being held in an Immigration Detention Centre, their only 'crime' fleeing genocide in their homeland in search of a peaceful life in Thailand. Once a week, believers teach them English and seek to show care for each one. Pray that their journey would lead them to find hope in Jesus.

23

F., a new believer, is working to get his 10-year ID card approved. "With this card," he says, "I can travel to share the Good News with my friends who have shown interest in Isa al-Masih." Praise God for his burden to share the gospel. Pray that the Good Shepherd would guide and protect him as he follows this calling.

24

To be a Rohingya in Thailand often means living in hiding, in constant fear of arrest. After being humiliated and exploited by traffickers during their dangerous journey, they hope for a better life. Pray that they would encounter the Shepherd who loves them and leads them on the straight path.

BANGLADESH

25

Pray for leaders in the community of believers in Bangladesh- that they would learn to follow the humble example of the Good Shepherd by serving their flock.

26

Thank God for the continued government permission to keep the clinic in the camps open and for sufficient funding. Pray that the clinic would be a place where people encounter Jesus in real and personal ways through their interactions with staff who are followers of Christ.

27

Pray that the 'brothers' and 'cousins' involved in the translation process would approach the Word not merely as an academic exercise or a job, but with their hearts and minds fully engaged in Scripture. Pray for those beginning to see Jesus for the first time through the translation of Matthew, and ask that their hearts would turn toward Him.

CHINA

28

Rohingya in China live near the Burmese border, in cities such as Ruili. Little is known about their lives, and no one is currently sharing the Good News with them. Pray that followers of Jesus would have hearts moved with compassion - praying for them and stepping out to guide them toward Jesus, the true Shepherd.

JAPAN

29

The Japanese government has funded the UN World Food Programme to support the Rohingya in Cox's Bazar. Mobility for Humanity is helping some travel to Japan to work or study, bringing hope for their futures. Praise God for these acts of care, and pray that believers in Japan would reach out and share Jesus with them.

U.A.E.

30

There are an estimated 50,000 Rohingya in the U.A.E. Life there is relatively stable, and they generally do not face discrimination. Pray for a deep spiritual hunger among the Rohingya, and for believers to pray for them and build meaningful connections to share Jesus.
