The following prayer requests are first-hand accounts from Rohingya people scattered across the globe – both Muslims and Christians. May the transforming power of the Gospel move among these beautiful people as we unite with them in bringing the cries of their heart before the eternal King. The one who can do far more than we could ever ask or imagine.

Dear brothers and sisters, pray for us.
[1 Thessalonians 5:25]

DAY

1

How can we go back to our home? How can we Rohingya become one again? This is my hearts cry for my people. Pray that God would answer my cry. - *Morium*

DAY

2

When I think of my people, I remember Jeremiah 29:11. The captivity of Israel to Babylon was a plan of God as well as a punishment. Yet, God gave them a hope and said He knows the plans he has for them, not to harm but to give them a hope and a future. Pray that God would reveal His plan for the Rohingya and give us a hope and a future.

DAY

3

The Rohingya in my area survive only because of the UNHCR (UN Refugee Agency) and the World Food Program. Pray for a more habitual environment in our camps. Pray also that the restrictions on our movement would be eased. - *Mustafar*

DAY

4

Please pray for me to be able to do my work of spreading the good news of Jesus Christ more widely in my community and make the whole Rohingya community understand about the Kingdom of the heaven. I am suffering and facing many difficulties as I spread the Gospel in my community. Please pray for my expat colleagues and friends who work for the Kingdom of God with me. - *Zafir*

DAY

5

I would like the world to know that we persecuted Rohingya refugees really want to return to Myanmar with full rights and justice. We did not come to Bangladesh to spend the rest of our lives in camps as refugees; we only came to Bangladesh to save our lives from genocide. Pray that we will be able to return to Myanmar. - *Mustafar*

DAY

6

I praise God because he is using me for the expansion of His kingdom. Pray that His glory may not depart from me and that I would always be used by Him.

DAY

7

The situations for my people in the refugee camps in Bangladesh is worse these days. Almost every day and night criminal groups set fires to homes and businesses. People are being more controlled, and many have been forced to move to the remote Island of Bhasan Char. It is not safe there. Pray that the Lord would take care of the many fire victims in the camps who lost everything.

8

Pray for the spiritual growth of the Rohingya Christians. Pray that conflict amongst them would come to an end.

9

When I think of my people my heart is distressed and I feel great compassion. They are a people without a country and their eyes are blind to eternal things. Their destiny is bad from two sides. The cry of my heart is that our Rohingya nation might know the True Path, both here on earth and in eternity. Please pray for this with me.

10

In our Rohingya community a Biblical theologian and a good doctor are needed. It's my prayer that my sons would be able to fill these roles. Pray for the opportunity for them to be educated and minister in our community in the future.

I want the world to know we Rohingya are also human and deserve the same rights as other people. Pray that we would receive equal rights. We are thankful for all the humanitarian aid provided for the Rohingya people.

12



13

Ask God to meet all our needs: education, rent, and other essentials. Pray also that our host country neighbours would have a positive and kind attitude towards us Rohingya.

DAY

14

The non-Muslim Rohingya minorities are becoming more depressed and desperate. They are living in restricted locations and lack basic needs. The authorities who are supposed to protect them are putting these families at risk. I believe my living God will take care of their needs according to His promises. Rohingya Christians who are victims of violence feel they have no options left, and ask you to pray that they would be resettled in another country that is safer.

Pray that God would save our hands from doing evil, protect us, and keep us from sin.

Pray that my people would become citizens of our nation, Myanmar. Pray that God would give them the gift of knowing the True Way of Jesus that they might have eternal peace.

DAY

17

My heart is always crying for my people because they are living in darkness without knowing the truth. Jesus said "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the father except through me." There are thousands of Rohingya who don't know about Jesus, and they will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven. My people's lives are full of suffering with many hardships and difficulties just to survive in this world. When they die without knowing Christ, they will lose the Kingdom of Heaven; then their suffering will be much more. Pray that my people would know and receive the Kingdom of Heaven through Jesus. - *Mustafar*

DAY

18

I want the world to know that we Rohingya are human. Please see us as human. Pray that the world would see us as human. Many people are using the Rohingya situation for their own personal gain. Pray that God would show them the right path. - *Ali*

DAY

19

How can we go back to our home? How can we Rohingya become one again? This is my hearts cry for my people. Pray that God would answer my cry. - *Morium*



DAY

20

Pray for Rohingya children to get full rights and access to education. They are the new generation and the hope for us persecuted Rohingya refugees. - *Mustafar*

DAY

21

My heart cries John 17:3 for my people. "O God, that they may know You". Pray that my people would know the one true God. Pray that they can go back to their homeland with full rights and citizenship. - *Abdulla*

DAY

22

Pray for the protection of Rohingya Christians, that they would be protected from harmful attacks because of their faith. - *Abdulla*

DAY

23

The situation of the Rohingya around us is so awful. They are facing difficulties with food, health, clothing, restricted movement, finance, employment, literacy, etc. So, please pray for them. - *Zafir*

DAY

24

Pray for our Rohingya Christian community to stay united and to echo with the Unity of the Holy Spirit, so that we can all work together for His Kingdom as we are Christ's image bearers among the lost around us. - *Muhammad*

DAY

25

We Rohingya are in vulnerable situations around the world. We desire that our human rights be honoured no matter what country we are living. We are eager to return to our homeland in Myanmar with full dignity, safety, and citizen rights. We also long for justice because of the loss of our people's lives, homes, and properties. Please pray for these things with us. - *Zafir*

We have placed our confidence in him, and he will continue to rescue us. And you are helping us by praying for us. Then many people will give thanks because God has graciously answered so many prayers for our safety. [2 Corinthians 1:10b – 11]

26

Pray for the current translation of the Bible in Rohingya. Pray that it would help all Rohingya come to the knowledge of the Truth. - *Abdulla*

DAY

28

The situation around me is not good. People are sick day after day and their worries continue to increase. We know that other's praying for us is of great benefit for us. Pray that we would be protected from evil things and choose to do what is right and good. - *Morium*

DAY

29

Over the years, many Rohingya I know have grown intolerant and even violent because of their hardships. There will be no peace and hope for them unless they repent and turn to the Lord Jesus. Pray that they would repent, and God would shine His light on them. - *Muhammad*

DAY

30

I would like to thank you immensely for keeping us in your mind, hearts, and prayers. God bless you for that. In the name of Jesus Christ, we are progressing forward successfully even though we face many difficulties physically, spiritually, and mentally. We seek your continued prayers because we are in so much need. - *Zafir*
